## Representative Matters

### Insurance

- Obtained judgment on the pleadings in a COVID-19 business interruption lawsuit brought by various hotel and casino properties.
- Partial summary judgment was obtained as a result of insured's violation of an aviation policy's pilot warranty.
- Summary judgment obtained as a result of insured's violation of captain warranty in marine policy.
- Favorable settlement for national insurer in highly contested coverage dispute arising out of alleged error in insured's name.

### Arbitration
