New York-based attorney Mohamed Sweify will participate in a "Third-Party Arbitration Funding" panel discussion on November 12, 2022. Among other issues, the panel will discuss the extent to which rules of legal ethics and professional responsibility apply to third-party funders of international arbitration.
